SPIRITUAL:

DEVELOPMENT:

- **ANNUAL FUND DRIVE:**
 - **CCES:** Families participating by Friday, September 8th will receive a free jean day pass for their child to use on Friday, September 25th. Each class that reaches 100% participation will receive a special class treat.
 - **CCHS:** September 8th is the deadline to earn the jean day pass for September 25th.

CCES ADMINISTRATIVE REMINDERS:

- **Birthday Day:** Student/teacher birthdays are celebrated on a designated Friday once a month. Summer months are included. Birthday students receive special recognition. On that day, **all** students may wear:
 - Plain, long blue denim approximately knee-length walking shorts, capris, or jeans - **NO** colored; ripped; striped; decorated jeans; jean skirts; overalls; jeggings.
 - Regulation school shorts or pants
 - Choice of Central Catholic t-shirt/sweatshirt or regulation uniform shirt
 - Choice of tennis shoes & socksDo not send class treats to school in celebration of individual birthdays without the **teacher's permission**. Gum, peanuts, nuts, and peanut butter are NOT allowed. Do not send balloons, flowers, etc. to school to an individual child. Birthday or other invitations may not be distributed at school unless the entire class or all girls or all boys are invited.
