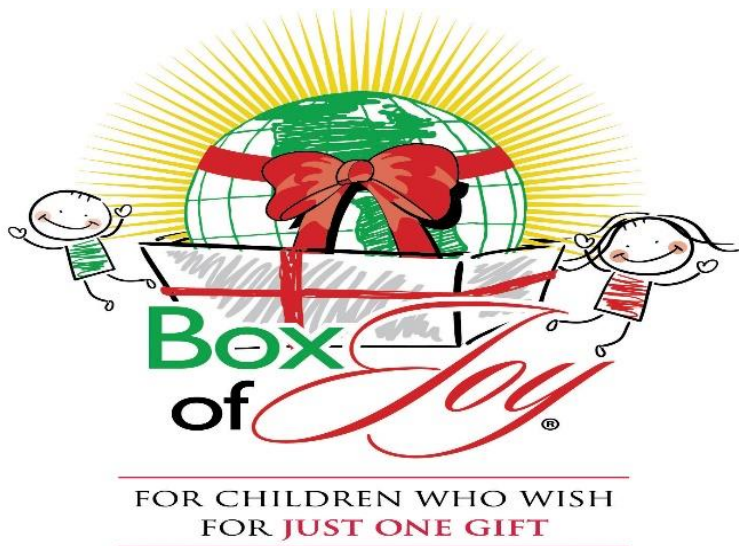
Feed My Lambs Project CCHS
