## **Local Scholarship Listing**

<u>Chamber of Commerce Scholarship (Assumption Area)</u> - Applicant must be a resident of Assumption Parish, A Senior at the school attending, planning to attend college. Applicant must be able to attend an interview at the scheduled time and date.

<u>Catholic Daughters of the Americas Scholarship</u>- Applicant must have resided in Louisiana at least one year prior to the high school graduation. Must have an overall academic GPA of 2.5 or higher for grades 9, 10, 11 and the first semester of grade 12. The Catholic Daughters of the Americas will award a \$200.00 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who will be entering an accredited college or university.

<u>Juliet Beadle Scholarship</u>- Student must be majoring in Education—graduating Senior who chooses to major in Elementary or Secondary Education.

Young Foundation Scholarship- Recipient must be a resident of Morgan City. They must be registered as a student in a four-year fully accredited college or university. Recipient must maintain a "C" average for the first year and then a "B" average with no grade below a "C" thereafter. Award is \$1,000.00 per semester for four years.

**George Allen Picou Scholarship**- Recipient will be selected by the Central Catholic Advisory Council. Student must maintain a "C" (2.0) GPA while in college in order to keep the scholarship. This scholarship is given in loving memory of Mr. Picou. The recipient will possess some of the same qualities which characterized him. Award is \$1,000.00 per semester for four years.

American Business Women's Association Scholarship - Scholarship is limited to an individual residing in Lafourche Parish or any surrounding parish and attending or preparing to attend, on a full time basis, Nicholls State University and/or any post-secondary institution, or Louisiana Technical College. Applicant must be seeking a business or professional career, must be of good character, and must show financial need. Applicant should be in good scholastic standing and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better each semester, quarter, or other academic period.

American Petroleum Institute (API) Scholarship - Recipient shall be a student enrolled in a high school in East St. Mary Parish, for at least two years prior to graduation. The API Scholarship Committee will base its final decision on the applicant's high school extracurricular activities and written essay. Recipients shall have a 3.0 average or better. The required GPA is based on preparatory course work for admission to an accredited university. Student shall have a minimum of 22 on the ACT. Four four-year scholarships will be awarded. Two of the four-year scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$12,000.00 to be paid at \$1,500.00 each semester for eight semesters and two four-year scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$4,000.00 to be paid at \$500.00 each semester for eight semesters.

**Rotary Club of Morgan City Scholarship**- Application and essay required.

Chamber of Commerce Scholarship (St. Mary Area) - Recipient shall be a student enrolled in an accredited high school in the St. Mary Parish area for a minimum of four continuous semesters upon graduation. Recipient should have a GPA of 3.0 or better for his/her Junior year and the first semester of his/her Senior year in high school. Student must take the ACT test and achieve a minimum score of 20. A need for financial assistance will be considered in awarding the \$1,000.00 scholarship.

**Louisiana Sheriff Scholarship**- Applicant must be a resident of a parish of Louisiana. Award funds must be utilized in an institution of higher learning within the state of Louisiana. The student must plan to be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student. There will be sixty-three scholarships awarded throughout the parish of a maximum of \$500.00 each.

MC Bank Scholarship (Hometown Spirit) - Must have extracurricular activities, grades, and good attendance record. MC Bank will grant the most qualified applicant. Each winner will receive a one-time cash award of \$1,500.00.

**East St. Mary Kiwanis Club Scholarship**- Applicant must be a member of the Central Catholic High School Key Club.

St. Mary AARP Scholarship- Applicant must have maintained an overall GPA of 2.5 in high school, must have completed his or her Junior and Senior years of school at a high school in St. Mary Parish. Applicant must enroll in a junior college, a university, or an institution that provides vocational training at a post-high school level in order to receive the proceeds of the scholarship. Parent/Grandparent must be a local AARP member (St. Mary AARP Chapter #4435). Two St. Mary Parish students who show a need and desire to further their education will each be awarded a \$1,000.00 scholarship. The scholarship recipient will receive \$250.00 award per year over a sequential 4-year period.

<u>McDonald's Scholarship</u>- This program is open to high school Seniors who demonstrate leadership, scholarship, by maintaining a minimum of "B" grade point average, character, and community service. Award will be \$1,000.00 to one outstanding student from one of the local high schools.

The Gentleman Scholarship- This scholarship is awarded to a high school graduating male who will be attending Nicholls State University. An ideal candidate for the scholarship is an individual who is actively involved in one or several competencies of being a successful undergraduate student. This includes scholarship, leadership, athletics, and philanthropy. Three incoming gentlemen will be chosen. One (1) will be rewarded a \$1,500.00 scholarship, while the remaining two (2) will be rewarded a \$500.00 scholarship apiece.

The Miles Liner Scholarship- This scholarship is awarded to a high school graduating senior who has superb leadership skills with at least 3 out of 4 years in 2 sports and 2 or more organizations per year, a cumulative GPA of 3.0, and a minimum ACT score of 20. Recipients are offered a one-time scholarship award valued at \$750.00.

<u>Horace Leger Scholarship</u>- Award will be determined by need with descendant of a veteran given preference. The recipient will be awarded a one-time scholarship valued at \$500.00.

<u>Pierre Part/Belle River Business Group Scholarship</u>- Application required.

Junior Auxiliary of East St. Mary Parish Scholarship- This scholarship will be given to a student to further his/her education by attending a college, university, vocational/technical, or nursing school. This student's future area of study or career plans must involve in some way: child welfare, child development, or education. The award amount is valued at \$2,000.00.

<u>Community Concert Association of Morgan City Scholarship</u>- Must have extracurricular activities, grades, and good attendance record. Student must also be planning on majoring in music or vocal education in college. CCA will grant the most qualified applicant. Each winner will receive a one-time cash award of \$750.00.

**Bayou Vista Garden Club Scholarship**- The purpose of the Bayou Vista Garden Club Scholarship Program is to provide assistance to high school seniors who are residents of Bayou Vista seeking to better himself or herself through an accredited vocational school, technical school, community college, or university in the State of Louisiana. The winner will receive a one-time cash award of \$500.00.

Teche Regional Medical Center Scholarship- Recipient shall be a student enrolled in an accredited high school in the St. Mary Parish area for a minimum of four continuous semesters upon graduation. Recipient should have a GPA of 2.5 or better and achieve a minimum score of 18 on the ACT test. Student must be planning to major in the field of nursing. This scholarship is valued at \$1,000.00 per semester for eight (8) semesters.
